ZWEIGELT ROSÉ FEDERSPIEL CLASSIC 2024

This rosé from Zweigelt exhibits depth and character. Well-defined red berry fruit with a crisp, elegant finish.

ORIGIN & TERROIR

Grapes for this Rosé are sourced from vineyards throughout the Wachau valley. A major part of the grapes are carefully hand-picked from vineyards surrounding the villages of Spitz and Weissenkirchen. The wine represents the typical cool climate style and the freshness with a characteristic minerality.

VINTAGE 2024

The year began unusually warm, with February recording the highest temperatures since weather records began. This led to early budding of the vines at the end of March. This was followed by extreme weather conditions ranging from late frosts and hail to periods of heat in the summer and heavy rain with flooding in September. However, thanks to the tireless work of our winegrowers and a precisely planned harvest (exceptionally early on September 3), we can be very satisfied with the quality of the wines despite all the adversity. The wines of the 2024 vintage present a balanced, racy acidity as well as the elegance and finesse that are so important to us.

VINEYARD & CELLAR

Blauer Zweigelt is quite easily manageable in the vineyards; however, yields tend to become too high without a rigid quantity control. The grapes for this Zweigelt Rosé were harvested by hand. The grapes were destemmed, crushed and after several hours of maceration, some of the must was separated and fermented in stainless steel tanks.

STYLE & CHARACTER

Open and playful on the nose, delicate aromas of strawberries, black currant and bramble, subtle hints of citrus and anise; lively, elegant, and fresh on the palate, fruity with a crisp acidity, well balanced. The name Federspiel is derived from falconry which was a very popular leisure time activity among the nobility in medieval times. The falcon stands for the remarkable elegance of these dry white wines. Serve well chilled at 8°C - directly from the fridge. Perfectly accompanies light starters, salads and fish dishes or serves as an elegant summer wine. We recommend that you drink it within the first year after bottling to enjoy the freshness and delicate fruit aromas of this young wine.

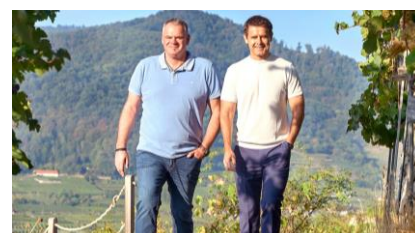
